Rules for Titles

- **A.** Titles of books, magazines, newspapers, plays, movies, TV shows, and recorded albums/CDs
 - 1. Place in italics (this clause is in italics) or underline (this clause is underlined).
 - Use italics whenever you can, such as when using a word processor.
 - b. Use underlining when you can't use italics, such as when handwriting or using a typewriter.
 - 2. Capitalize the first word.
 - 3. Capitalize the last word.
 - 4. Capitalize all other words except for these:

a	by	on	to
an	for	or	up
and	in	out	yet
at	nor	so	
but	of	the	

- **B.** Titles of short stories, poems, articles in a magazine or newspaper, and songs
 - 1. Place in quotation marks ("this clause is in quotation marks").
 - 2. Follow the same capitalization rules as for longer works (see above).
